If I **study**, I **will pass** my exams.

PRESENT SIMPLE

FUTURE SIMPLE

I **will pass** my exams if I **study**.

We use it to talk about possible situations
and their consequences in the future.

FIRST CONDITIONAL

+ If I **study**, I **will pass** my exams.

- If I **don't study**, I **won't pass** my exams.

? If I **study**, **will** I **pass** my exams?

+ If he **studies**, he **will pass** his exams.

- If he **doesn't study**, he **won't pass** his exams.

? If he **studies**, **will** he **pass** his exams?
