We use it to talk about possible situations and their consequences in the future.

- If I don't study, I won't pass my exams.
- ? If I study, will I pass my exams?

- + If he studies, he will pass his exams.
- If he doesn't study, he won't pass his exams.
- ? If he studies, will he pass his exams?
